Summer Registration Process

Registering for summer is a two-step process. We try to make it as simple as possible, but summer schedule is tricky, so allow yourself some time to get through the sign up process. I recommended signing up for the private lesson days/times you want ASAP as they will fill up.

FIRST:

Step 1: Sign up for the package your child plans to participate in [HERE](#) (please list the child's name when you sign up rather than yours). *If you have a question as to what is best for your child, please consult with your private lesson teacher first!*

SECOND:

Step 2: Depending on the Package you choose, you will sign up for private lessons with the teacher of your choice.

- If you choose [Package A](#), you will sign up for 5 private lessons plus any/as many of the group classes as you'd like.
- If you choose Package B, you can sign up for 6 ONE HOUR lessons, or 8 45-minute lessons. There are no group classes in this package and *you will sign up via the individual teacher sign up links.*
- If you choose Package B with the (six) ONE HOUR lesson option you can ONLY sign up for the FIRST or LAST slot of the day and you MUST NOTATE THIS in the sign-up.
- When signing up, it would be EXTREMELY helpful if you signed your child up as Student Name 1 of 2, Student Name 2 of 2, etc...so you can keep track of the number you are signing up for.
- [Package C](#) will be scheduled based on interest and will have a minimum of 10 students.

Rules

Any lessons moved 2 days prior to the scheduled lesson will be forfeited. We plan our schedules accordingly, and expect the same level of respect for our teachers and their time. A last-minute play date is not a good reason to reschedule a pre-existing music lesson commitment. An open slot on a teacher's calendar is a slot that could potentially have been filled by someone else. We have hands down, the best teaching faculty in North Dallas, and one of the reasons is because we respect them as professional teaching artists. This is one of the best ways we can show our respect and appreciation for all they do.

Lessons are first-come, first-serve so if you know you will be in town, get the kids signed up before the slots fill.
